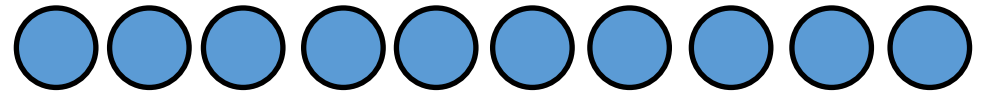

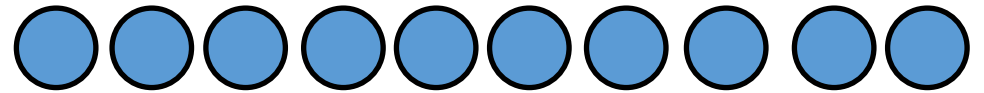

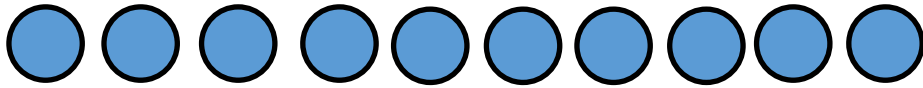

# Ag Art Contest

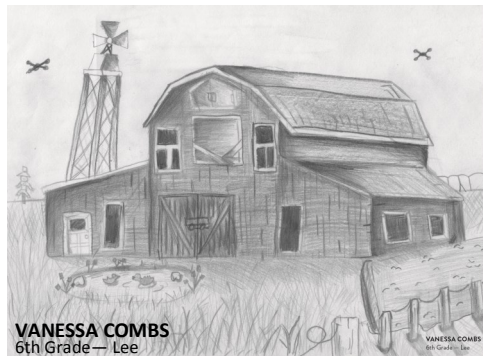


The Mississippi Farm Bureau Ag Art Contest offers Farm Bureau Women an opportunity to reach students in grades 1-6 and 7-12 to increase their awareness of the importance of agriculture in Mississippi through the Ag in the Classroom Program.

### Title of Contest

## "Down on the Farm"

Farm scenes, animals, agricultural crops, etc., may be used. Winners' artwork will be used in the 2020 Ag Art Calendar.



## CONTEST GUIDELINES

- The contest is open to Mississippi students in grades 1-6 and 7-12.
- The finished artwork must be hand drawn on 8½ x 11-inch white paper in landscape format (horizontal).
- It should be either in black ink or dark pencil (soft lead).
- Only black and white artwork will be accepted.
- The student must be willing to allow Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation to reprint copies of their artwork. The winning artwork becomes the property of Mississippi Farm Bureau Federation.
- All information on the entry form must be completed, including the signature of the parent or guardian.
- **Entries should be submitted to the county Farm Bureau office by MARCH 1.**
- Calendar winners must skip one year before resubmitting artwork for Ag Art Contest.

Drawings will be judged on the following:

- ORIGINALITY
- INTERPRETATION
- CREATIVITY
- MISSISSIPPI AGRICULTURE
- ARTISTIC MERIT
- DEPICTS AGRICULTURE - PAST OR PRESENT

### PRIZES:

6 state winners from Grades 1-6 will receive \$75.  
6 state winners from Grades 7-12 will receive \$75.  
Overall Winner in each division will receive \$100.
