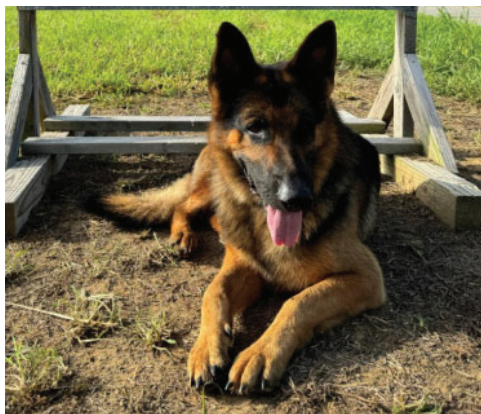

"Farm dogs make life on the farm worth living. They are not just part of the farm, they are part of our family."

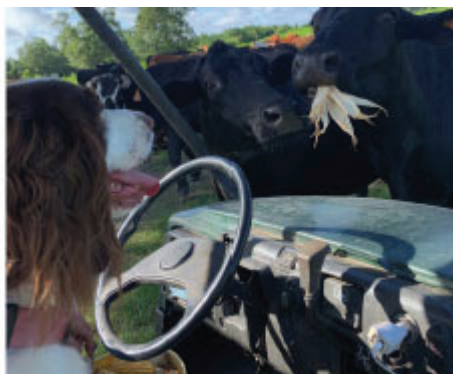

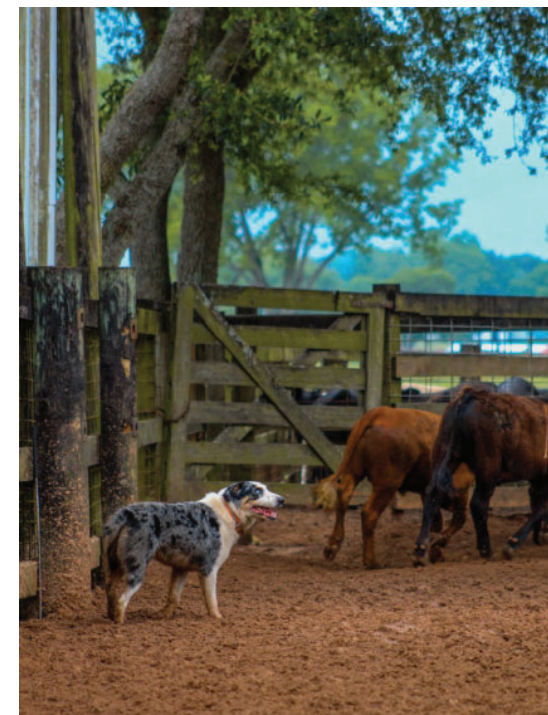

GUIDELINES

- Must complete entry form.
- To be eligible for contest, all images and entry forms must be submitted in one email, electronically to SWLC@msfb.org
- Entries must be received by:

August 1, 2025

- 2 Photos should be submitted in TIFF or JPG (preferred resolution is 300 DPI or a minimum of 150 DPI).

Tips for keeping image quality high

- *If sending from a phone, make sure you select ACTUAL SIZE when prompted. This will ensure the image isn't downsized when sending.*
- *If sending from a computer, make sure to say no if it asks you to compress images for email.*
- *High resolution images will usually have to be sent one or two at a time.*
