ELIGIBILITY

Mississippi Classroom Teachers Grades K-12

The Ag in the Classroom (AITC) Teacher of the Year award recognizes an exceptional educator who incorporates agricultural literacy into their classroom, inspiring students to understand and appreciate the importance of agriculture in their daily lives.

Responsibilities of the Teacher of the Year

Presentation Requirement:

The selected teacher will be a featured presenter on the first day of the 2026 AITC Teacher Workshops.

He or she will teach one session during the two workshops.

Tour Participation:

The teacher will have the opportunity to attend one tour day of their choice during the workshops.

Benefits of Being Selected

Grant Opportunities:

The teacher will receive the following:

- ◆ \$500 monetary award
- ◆ \$500 monetary award to be used in their classroom for agricultural education activities or resources.
- ◆ Transportation, registration, and one dinner meal will be paid for the teacher to attend the **National Agriculture in the Classroom Conference**.

◆ National Recognition Opportunity:

The recipient is encouraged to apply for the **National Agriculture in the Classroom Teacher of the Year Award** to showcase their outstanding contributions to agricultural education. MS Farm Bureau Federation will only endorse the current Teacher of the year.

GUIDELINES

- ◆ Candidates must demonstrate creativity and excellence in incorporating agricultural concepts into their teaching.
- ◆ Specific examples of agricultural education activities or lessons.
- ◆ The impact of these activities on student learning and engagement.
- ◆ Plans for utilizing the monetary award to enhance agricultural literacy in the classroom.
- ◆ Previous Teacher of the Year winners may apply again after 5 years.

Teachers must submit a 250-300 word essay on a program or an activity that has been used in the classroom during the school year.

The essay should highlight:

- ◆ Specific examples of agricultural education activities or lessons.
- ◆ The impact of these activities on student learning and engagement.
- ◆ Plans for utilizing the monetary award to enhance agricultural literacy in the classroom.
