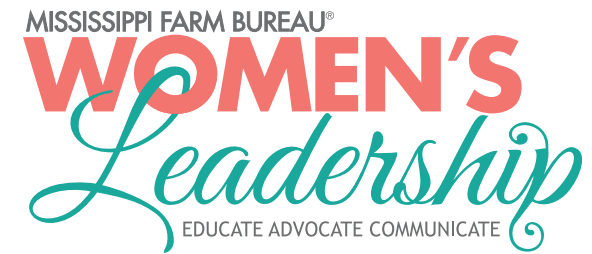

CONTEST GUIDELINES

- The contest is open to all Mississippi Farm Bureau members and employees over the age of 18 at the time of entry.
- **Amateur photographers only.**
- All photos must be taken in Mississippi.
- **Applicants may submit 2 entries per category, per member number.**
- Applicants may only submit each photo once, as an attachment and it should be accompanied by a completed Entry and Release Form.
- Photos should be submitted in TIFF or JPG (**preferred resolution is 300 DPI or a minimum of 150 DPI**).

Tips for keeping image quality high

- If sending from a phone, make sure you select **ACTUAL SIZE** when prompted. This will ensure the image isn't downsized when sending.
- If sending from a computer, make sure to say no if it asks you to compress images for email.
- High resolution images will usually have to be sent one or two at a time.

- Fill out the Photo Contest Entry and Release Form must include 1 per photo.
- All Forms Must have a **FB Membership** number and both pages be completed.
- Each Image and entry form must be submitted as an attachment via email : SWLC@msfb.org (**Please only one submission per email**)
- Entries must be received by:

SEPTEMBER 2, 2026

- All photographs must be your own original creation.
- All contest submissions will be considered for future MFBF publications, website, and newsletters.
- Winners will be notified by October 23, 2026.
